Phases of Budget Development

Timelines	Phases
February	Setting the Stage – confirm projected enrolment & other revenue
March	Financial Review – Identify pressures/relief
April	Budget Building – develop options to address pressures /relief
May ECOW	Budget Review — 1st reading
May Board	Budget Review – 2 nd /3 rd readings and approval
June	Budget Submission to MoE



- ☐ Staff still working on final details of the 18/19 base budget
- ☐ Taken the knowns and stakeholder input to draft initial plan
- ☐ Factoring in potential remaining funds from 17/18
- Draft will be ready for BMT on May 1





- ☐ Per Pupil Funding increase from \$7,301 to \$7,423 to cover CA
- ☐ 18/19 estimate of 10,641 students = \$98.486 million
- ☐ 17/18 actual of 10,295 students = \$93.729 million
- ☐ Estimated increase of ~346 students and \$4.757 m from 17/18
- ☐ Student estimates include Standard, Continuing Ed and Alternate



Incremental Revenues:



Estimated increase = \$4.882 m

Highlighted increases include:

- \$4.757 m in grant revenue
- \$.125 m incremental International revenue



Incremental Expenditures:

Estimated increase = \$4.530 m

Highlighted increases include:

- \$2.422 m in negotiated salary & benefits
- \$.800 m in enrolling teachers (8)
- \$.431 m in Student Support Services
- \$.365 m in Employer Health Tax
- \$.150 m in additional bus route & fuel costs
- \$.080 m in OHS mandated training
- \$.250 m in reserve



Incremental Revenues: \$4.882 m

Incremental Expenditures: \$4.530 m

Potential Relief \$.352 m

Note: Amounts are fluid and will continue to evolve
